

ASSISTANT PROFESSOR
Early Childhood/Elementary Teacher Education Program

The Department of Interdisciplinary Learning and Teaching in the College of Education and Human Development at the University of Texas at San Antonio, a recognized, Hispanic-serving institution, invites applications for one tenure-track position at the Assistant Professor level position, beginning Fall 2008.

Responsibilities include: (a) teaching courses that may include field-based work in diverse sites in the EC-6 undergraduate interdisciplinary teacher education program, (b) advising graduate students, (c) teaching graduate courses, (d) conducting an active program of research, (e) providing service to department, college, university, community constituencies and professional field, and (f) seeking grant funding.

Required Qualifications: (a) an earned doctorate by May 31, 2008 in curriculum and instruction, teaching and teacher education, early childhood/elementary education or related field; (b) evidence of three years of teaching in EC-6 state accredited schools or the equivalent; (c) demonstrated experience with and knowledge of students from culturally diverse populations; (d) demonstrated potential for teaching excellence, and (e) an articulated research agenda.

Preferred Qualifications: (a) university teaching and supervisory experience; (b) evidence of collaborative work between schools and university; (c) experience with field-based teacher education; (d) demonstrated experience in interdisciplinary education (e) additional experience with any of the following: science and math education, bilingual education, educational technology or instructional technology and online/distance learning, gifted education, multicultural education, special education, educational assessment or other related fields of study, (f) experience in seeking external funding, and (g) demonstrated research record.

Initial Review:

Candidates must submit an application letter that addresses the required and preferred qualifications; a current dated curriculum vitae; 1-2 page description of research plans and samples of published or submitted work; copies of official transcripts; names, addresses, email addresses, and telephone numbers of three references. Review of completed applications will begin immediately and will continue until the position is filled. Applicants who are selected for interviews must be able to show proof that they are eligible and qualified to work in the United States.
